Lillstreet Scholarship Policies & Guidelines

Please keep for your own information

- 1. Lillstreet provides a scholarship program to help students with limited financial means gain access to our education offerings and community. Applicants must complete an application form for every session in which they request financial assistance. Applying is not a guarantee of receiving financial aid.
- Scholarship funds are limited and financial aid award decisions are made two weeks before the starting date of each session. Applications received after that time will be considered only if scholarship funds are still available. Financial aid grant amounts may be limited based on the size of the applicant pool.
- 3. Students awarded a scholarship must attend at least 90% of classes. Instructors will keep records of your attendance and will submit a student evaluation at the end of the session. Failure to attend class will result in forfeiture of enrollment and all fees paid.
- 4. Scholarships will be available for one class per term per student.
- 5. Refunds and class credits are not available for scholarship students. In the case of documented medical reasons, scholarship students are eligible for a prorated studio credit of the portion of the class paid by the student (that is, non-scholarship funds).
- 6. Scholarships are non-transferable and valid for only the session in which they are granted.
