

New Building Safety Protocols

Following the guidelines for [businesses](#) and [day camps](#) reopening in Phase 4 of Restore Illinois.

Cleaning Procedures

- **Lillstreet will hire a full-time custodian** and 2 additional part-time cleaning staff members, who will routinely clean each day, Monday–Sunday.
- **Classrooms will be completely sanitized** between classes throughout the day.
- **Increased hand sanitizer stations** can be found throughout our building.
- **Doors and windows will remain open** wherever possible in order to increase ventilation.

Class size Limitations

- **Class sizes will be limited to 8 students.** This will ensure that class meetings will fall under the 10-person gathering limit including instructors.

Student Precautions and Protocols

- **Self-Health screenings are required before entry:** check to see if you are exhibiting any [Covid-19 symptoms](#) prior to building entry. If you do have symptoms, wait to enter premises until you have had no fever for at least 72 hours, other symptoms have improved, and at least 10 days have passed since your symptoms first appeared.
- **Before entering your classroom, please use hand sanitizer.** We will have sanitizer available outside of each classroom.
- **All students must maintain a 6-foot distance** between non-household individuals when possible.
- **Masks must be kept on at all times while inside our building.**
- **Pre-class check-ins:** Check-ins will no longer take place in-person, at the front desk, prior to your first class meeting. You will receive specific check-in information the week before your class begins.
- **Water fountains will no longer be available for use.** Please be sure to bring your own water!

Summer Camp Protocols

- **Health screenings are required before entry:** check to see if your child is exhibiting any [Covid-19 symptoms](#) prior to building entry. If your child does have symptoms, they should wait to enter premises until they have had no fever for at least 72 hours, other

symptoms have improved, and at least 10 days have passed since their symptoms first appeared.

- **Upon entering the building, campers must use hand sanitizer. We will have a sanitizer available outside of each classroom.**
- **Parents, teachers, and campers must wear face coverings at all times.**
- **All campers must maintain a 6-foot distance** between non-household individuals when possible.
- **Drop-off and Pick-up:** campers will receive camp check in instructions the Friday before their camp is scheduled to start.
- **Campers will stay with their assigned group** to limit the number of people they come into contact with each day.
- **Water fountains will no longer be available for use.** Please be sure to send your child to camp with enough water for the day.
- **Campers must bring their own lunch that will be eaten with their camp group in the classroom.**
- **Field trips will not be offered.**

These guidelines are created with your safety in mind. If you do not adhere to these protocols, you will be asked to leave in order to protect the health and safety of your fellow classmates, teachers, and our staff.
